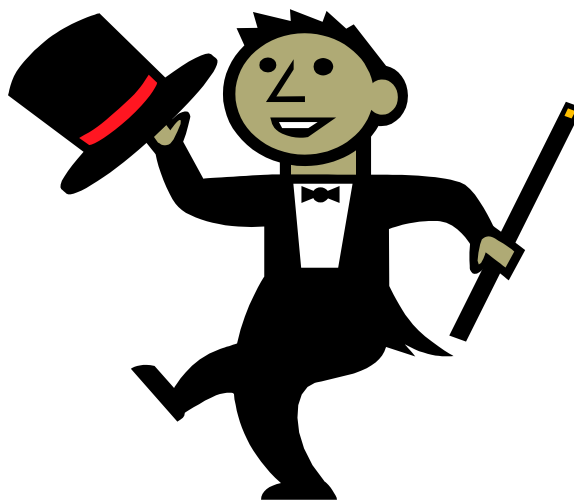

As you get ready for college, you have the opportunity to participate in five fun summer activities to build your presentation skills, including self-advocacy, interviewing, working effectively with others and being comfortable in diverse settings. This program is presented in collaboration with the Hartford Stage.

Session 1: Building an Ensemble – Students will work in teams on a group challenge -- to work as a group to devise and perform a short play based on a familiar story. Each student will begin to recognize his or her own unique voice and talents, while working together with a group.

Session 2: Improvisation – Through basic improvisation games and exercises, students will become skilled improvisers, while building confidence, learning to think on their feet, and continuing to build trust within the ensemble.

Session 3: Auditions and Interviews – This session will introduce students to the basics of auditioning & presenting themselves to others.

Session 4: Putting It All Together – Extemporaneous speeches (1 minute minimum) on topics provided by the staff, reading journal excerpts about their experiences, and sharing expectations for college
